GET READY: New NIH Policy on Data Management and Sharing, Effective January 25, 2023

- NIH requires researchers to submit a Data Management and Sharing Plan (Plan). This policy applies to all research, funded or conducted in whole or in part by NIH, that results in the generation of scientific data.
- Plan will be submitted with any grant application.
- Plan will be part of the budget justification section.
- Plan will be two pages or less

Compliance

- Once a grant has been awarded, the Plan becomes part of the award's terms and conditions.
- NIH expects researchers and institutions to implement data management and sharing practices as described in their approved Plan.
- Compliance with the Plan, including any Plan updates, may be reviewed during regular reporting intervals.

Plans should include the following:

- **Data Type** - Description of the scientific data to be managed, preserved, and shared
- **Related Tools, Software and/or Code** - Explanation of any specialized tools needed to access or manipulate shared scientific data.
- **Standards** - Description of common data standards, if any, applied to the scientific data and associated metadata.
- **Data Preservation, Access, and Associated Timelines** - List of repositories where data will be archived as well as documentation of how data will be discoverable and when it will be made available.
- **Access, Distribution, or Reuse Considerations** - Explanation of any issues affecting subsequent access, distribution, or reuse of data.
- **Oversight of Data Management and Sharing** - Plans for how compliance will be monitored and managed.
