





# **Huron Disclosure System**

### What's Huron?

Huron is a disclosure system that will be used to centralize <u>Financial Conflicts of Interest</u> (previously in Maestro), <u>Conflict of Commitment disclosures</u>, and <u>Faculty Consulting/External Employment</u> approval requests.

#### A few things to note:

- 1) <u>Pre-Approval Request</u>: this process will be utilized to meet the requirements of **System Regulations 31.05.01 and 31.05.02**.
- 2) <u>COI Disclosure</u>: this now includes financial conflicts of interest (for investigators only), as well as conflict of commitment and federal requirement questions.







# **Objectives/Goals**

- 1. Improve compliance with current disclosure and approval routing processes.
- 2. Improve approval process by establishing logical workflow for review based on review types and content.
- 3. Support institutional needs for a consistent approval process and provide metrics for the use of the programs, to support continued success of the institutional partners.
- 4. Increase institutional and individual compliance with federal, state, and university rules and regulations.

  - Conflict of Commitment Disclosures
  - Financial Conflict of Interest

  - TrainTraq
  - SSO
  - IRB (HRS Implementation)
  - Maestro
  - People/Organizations database (Workday)







The <u>Disclosure Profile</u> is the focal point of the Huron system for the discloser. It provides a summary of discloser's interest and everything that was disclosed previously.

As a discloser, you need to record your interests in the Huron system. You will receive an e-mail notification when you need to disclose your interests in the system. You can either click the link in the e-mail notification or go to your Disclosure Profile in the Huron application to disclose your interest.


